Scholarship Guidelines / Process / Application

Please use this form to request a full or partial scholarship for a specific season, camp or clinic. Depending upon a variety of factors, the board may decide to award the full amount requested, or, may award a partial amount.

I. Applicant must contact the Coastal Dragons Board and submit a written application (this form and required attachments) and \$50 application fee to the Coastal Dragons Board. Payment can be made when registering.

Players applying for a scholarship need to demonstrate a desire to play the game of rugby, show positive sporting character and attitude both on and off the pitch, and represent the Club well at all times. This must continue while on a scholarship. These principles are a player's responsibility and failure to uphold them may result in a voiding of scholarship.

- II. In order to qualify for sponsorship or scholarship aid, the player must:
 - A. Have and maintain a minimum 'C' (2.0) average in school.
 - B. Provide a copy of report card or printout of a school progress report at time of application.
 - C. Provide a progress report in mid-season.
 - D. If a scholarship is granted and a player has an 'F' in any class they will not be eligible to play, even with a 'C' average, until grade is raised (note from teacher, or print out from the school progress system will be required confirming grade has improved).
 - E. Player must not have been in trouble with the law within the past 12 months.
 - F. If awarded a scholarship and a player receives a red card or multiple (three or more) yellow cards, the Board will convene a disciplinary committee to review and determine any action(s). This may include voiding the player's scholarship.
 - G. Should a scholarship be voided the player may be required to pay any or all CIPP and SCYR registration fees, plus prorated season fees, before being eligible to participate in any further Club practices or games.

III. Once submitted, the board will review the application and may request a meeting with the player and parents/applicant.

IV. After the meeting, if any, the board will inform the parents/applicant of the decision and the amount of the scholarship. If a full scholarship is granted, all fees for registration will be waived.

V. The Club Board will hold knowledge of the application, decision and any award in confidence, with no outward distinction of any kind.
